

Dear Community Members:

In the 95 years our little library has been located at 273 Beaver Dam Road, there have been many changes to not only our surrounding area but in how our facility has been utilized by the public.

In order to meet the needs of today and better preserve for the future, a Site Improvement Project is expected to begin shortly. The plan seeks to address severe drainage and accessibility issues, while enhancing the overall aesthetic of the property. Formulated over the course of nearly three years, the Board engaged the help of various design and planning professionals to determine how best to accomplish the desired outcomes. The addition of drainage pools, improved handicapped parking, new walkways, some defined parking spaces, regrading of the lawn, landscaping and a new fence are key elements of this plan.

This project is funded with Capital Reserves so we are not seeking additional funding from tax payers. Our intention is for the work to be completed in the early part of the summer months so that we will be able to offer some in-person outdoor events upon completion. Please note that the nature of the construction work may temporarily limit access to the Library or it may be necessary to close. Any service interruptions will be as brief as necessary.
